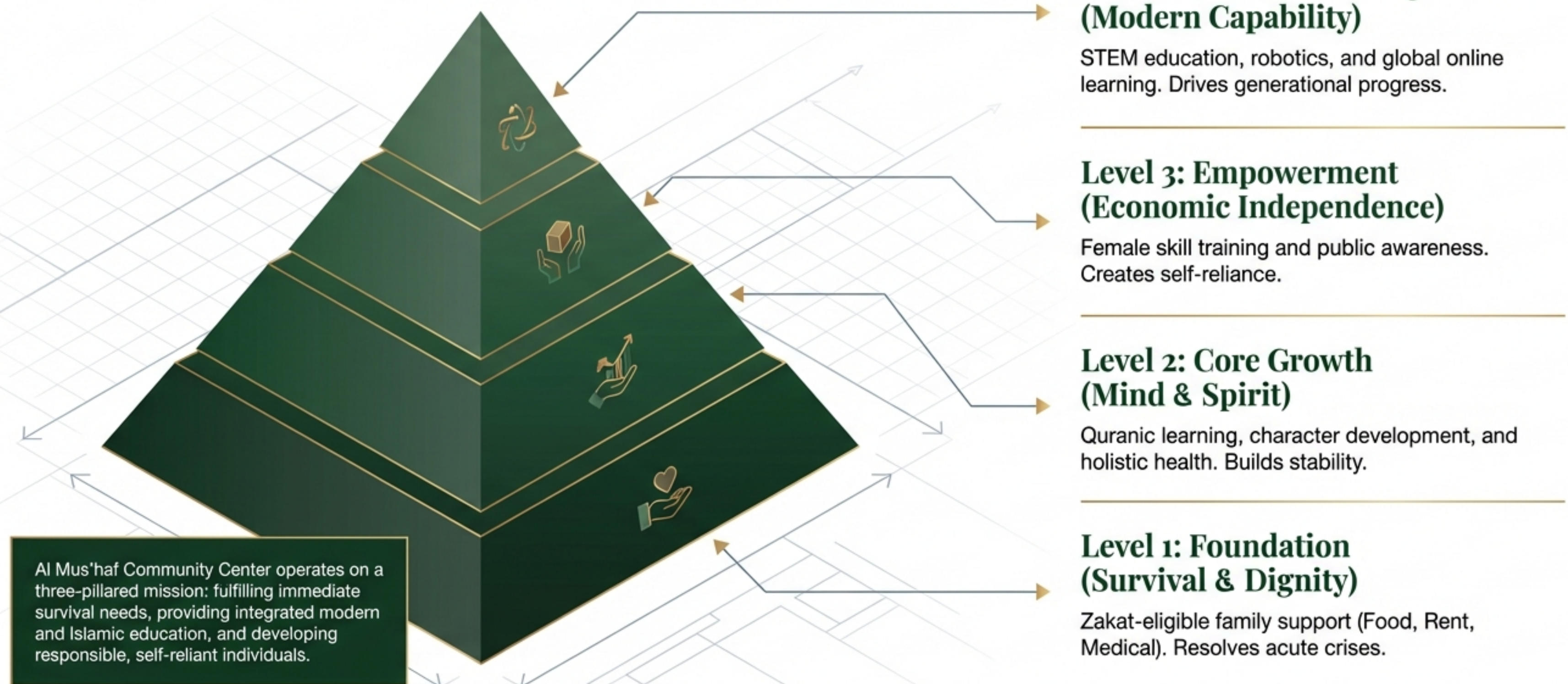

Securing the foundation through transparent Zakat distribution



Funds are allocated fluidly based on strict, Shariah-compliant assessments of individual household needs, prioritizing dignity and basic survival.

Addressing structural vulnerabilities with targeted support



The Widow-Led Household

Profile: Single mothers relying on small domestic work.

Primary Interventions: Groceries, utility relief, and uninterrupted schooling for children.



The Medical Hardship

Profile: Households paralyzed by chronic illness, disability, or elderly care requirements.

Primary Interventions: Critical medicines and total dependency support.



The Orphaned Household

Profile: Children under the care of extended family (e.g., grandmothers) with zero primary income.

Primary Interventions: Sustained food security and educational continuity.



The Daily Wager

Profile: Families facing inflation-driven food and rent insecurity due to unstable, irregular income.

Primary Interventions: Rent stabilization to keep families housed.

Outcome: A resilient community grounded in shared values and **proactive family development.**

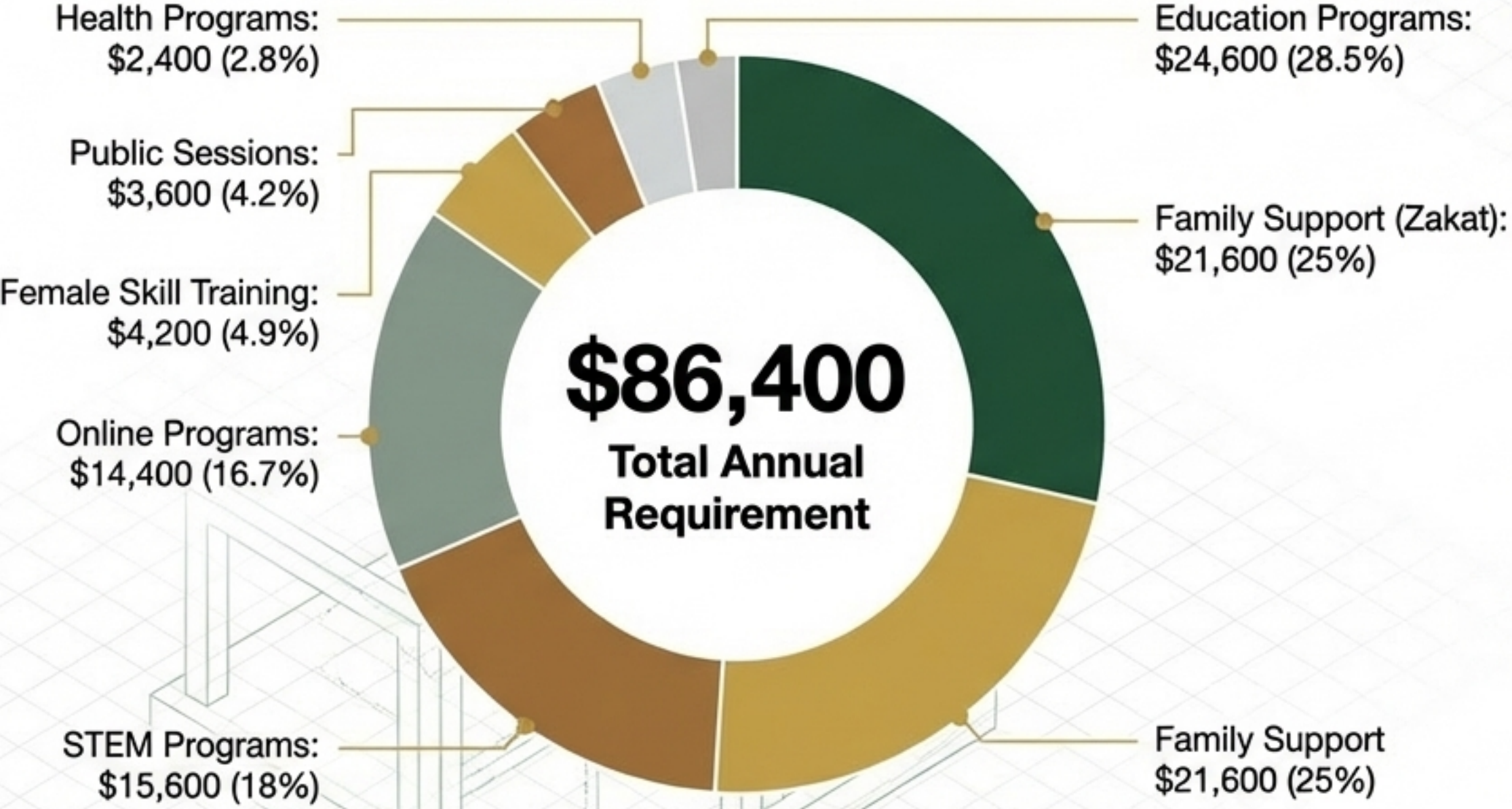
